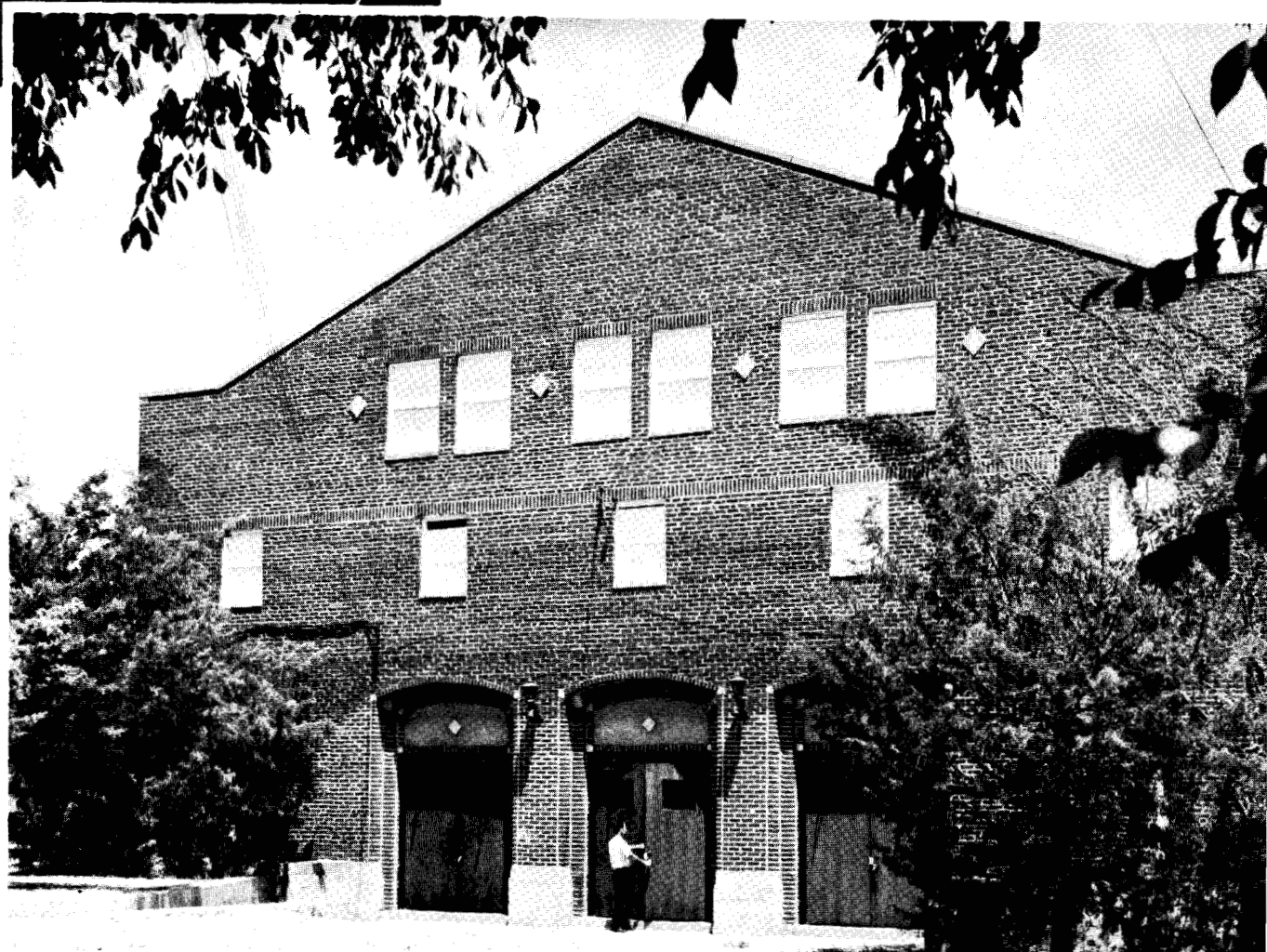


HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION BUILDING

building now under construction.



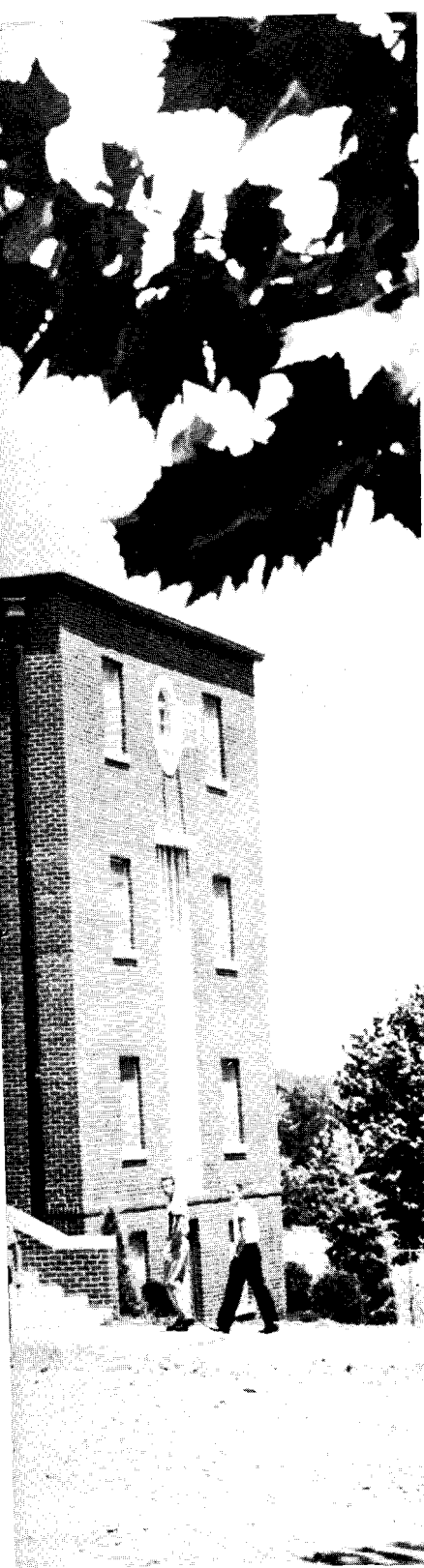

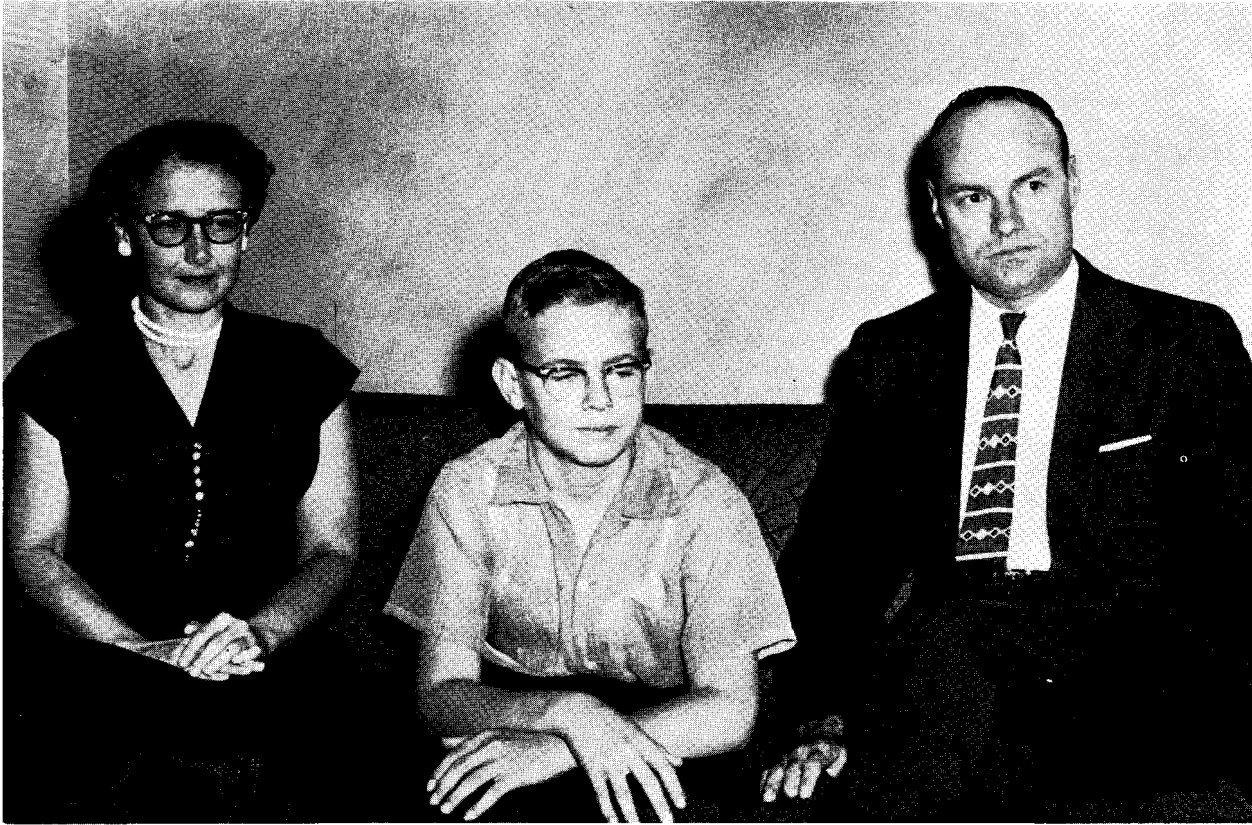

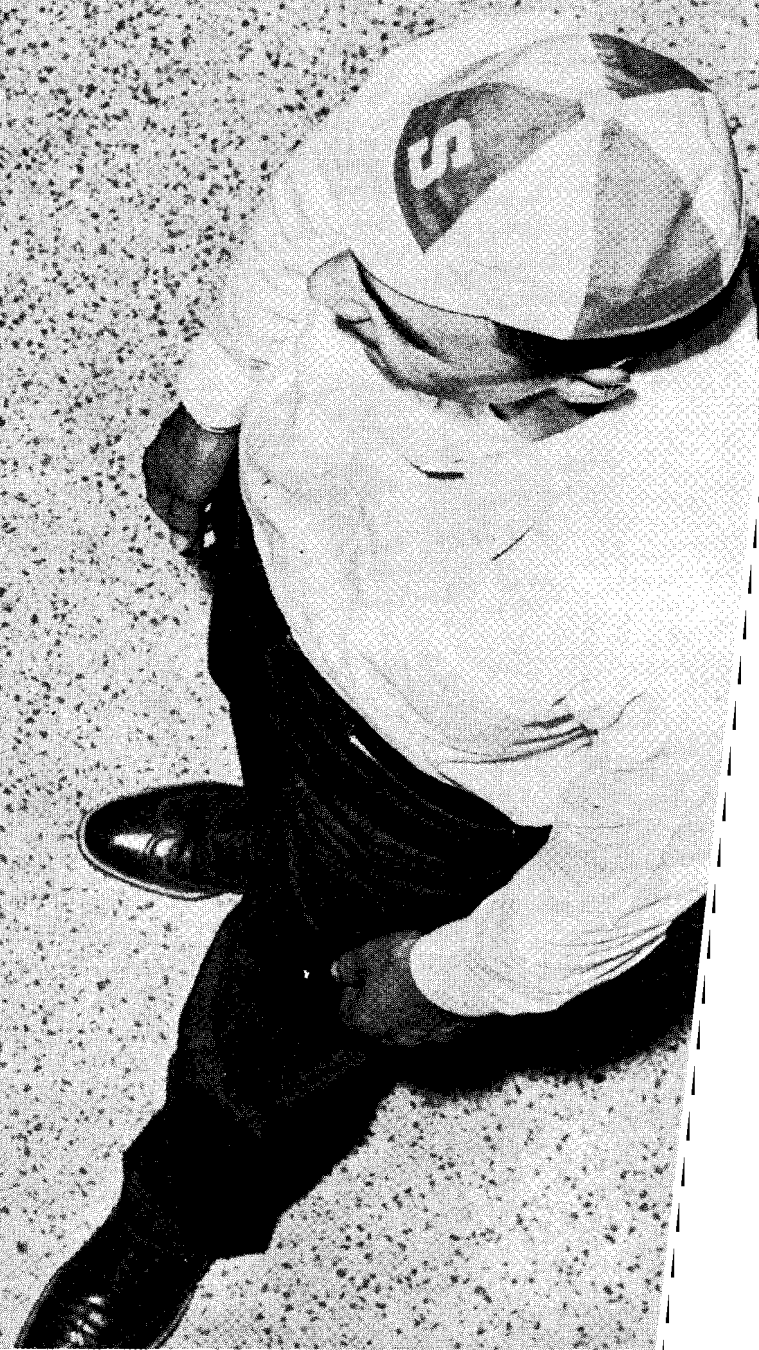
