Southeastern State College joined with Durant September 14 and 15, 1957, in staging one of the most impressive Oklahoma semi-centennial celebrations.

Dr. James D. Morrison, history professor and acting dean of instruction, served as general chairman and director of the city's significant observance of the 100th anniversary of the noted Butterfield Overland Mail.

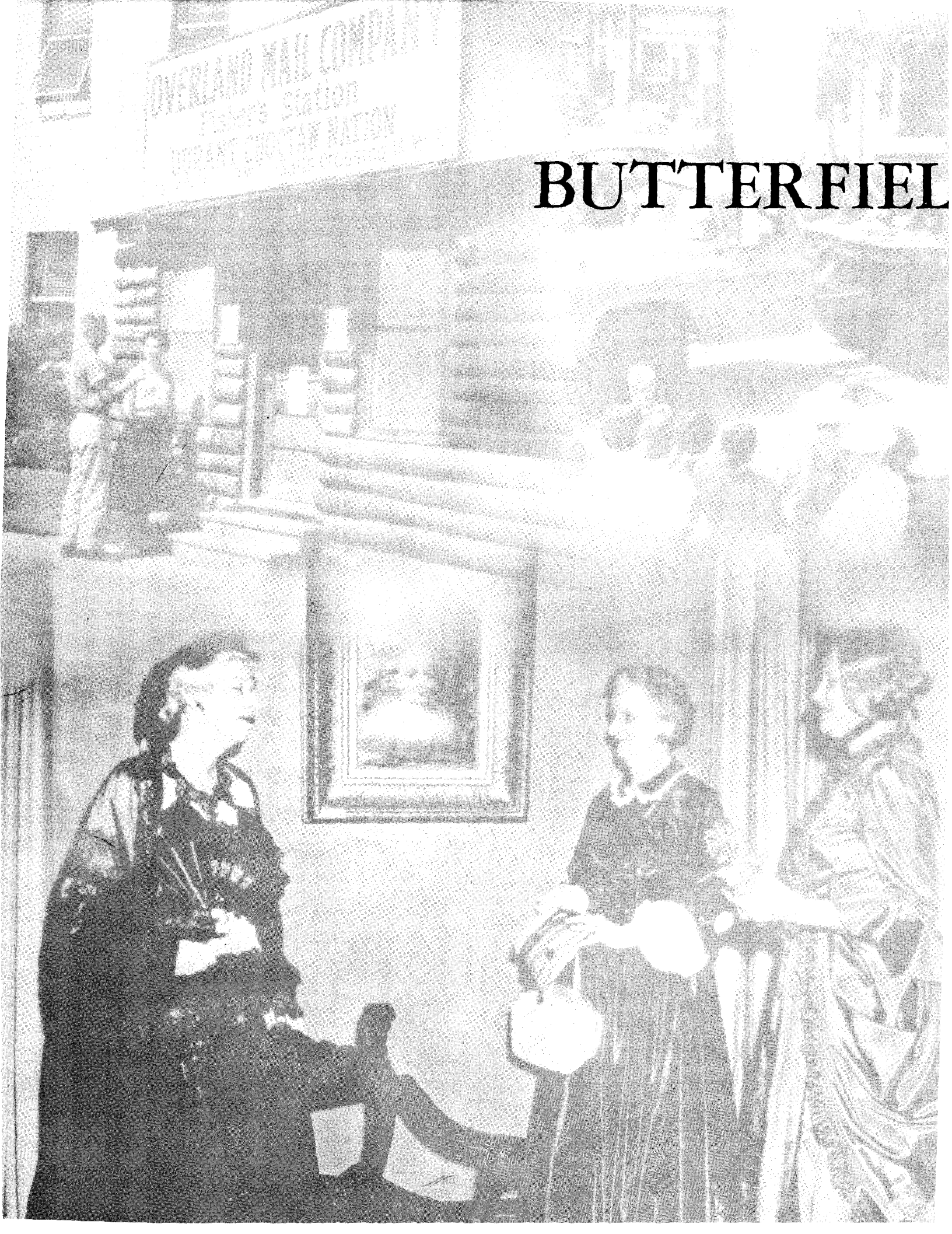
An authentic four-horse stagecoach made a re-run of a portion of the famous route, from Atoka to Colbert, where an historical marker was dedicated.

Stamp collectors in all parts of the country and in Canada sent in mail to be carried on the stagecoach and stamped with the special Butterfield cancellation.

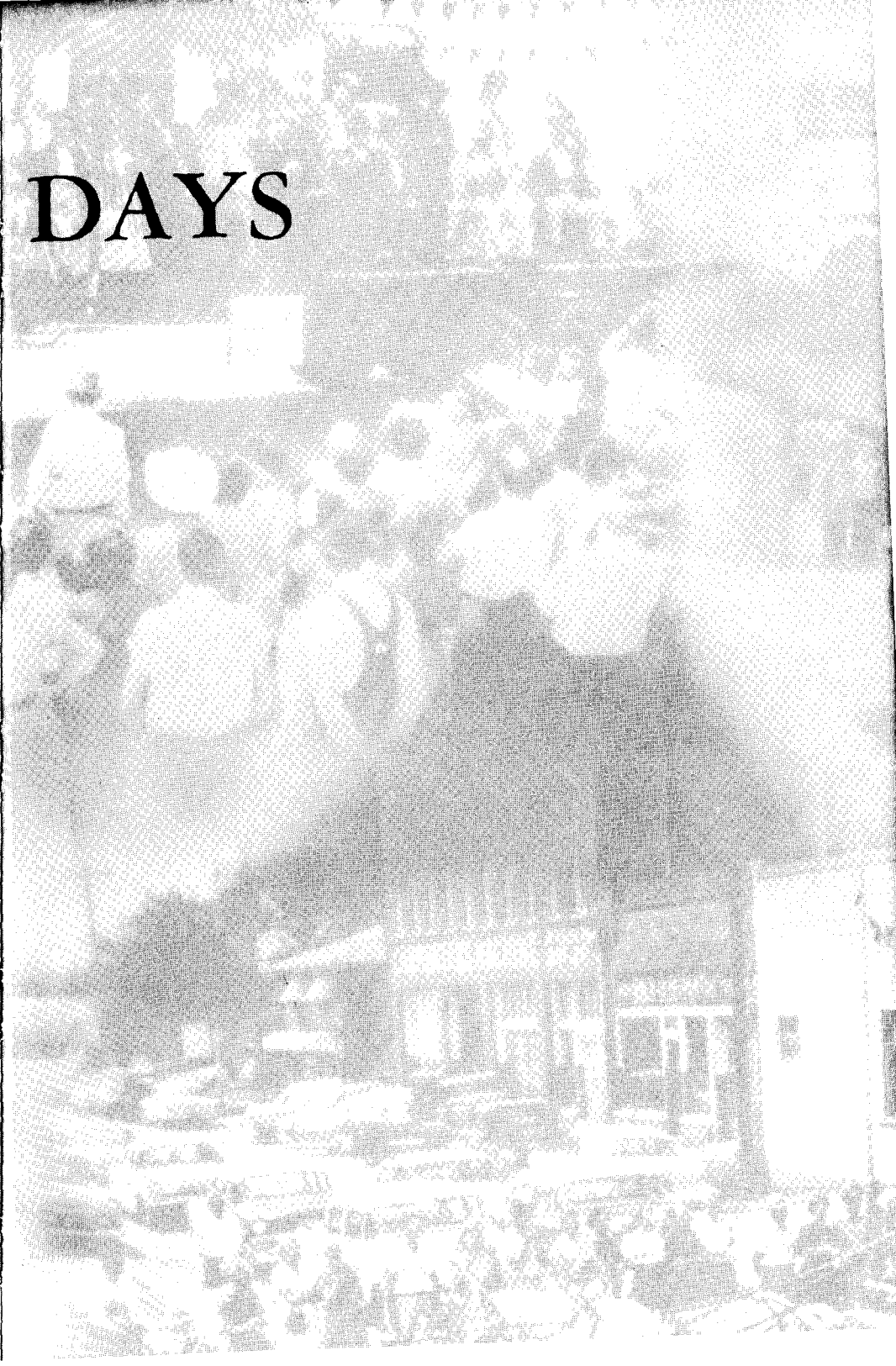
Mrs. Floy Perkinson Gates, head of the English department, was another Southeastern faculty member who played a key role in the colorful two-day celebration. Mrs. Gates served as chairman of the Pioneer Homecoming event, in which "Mr. and Mrs. John Butterfield of 1357" were selected from candidates representing southern Oklahoma and northern Texas towns.
