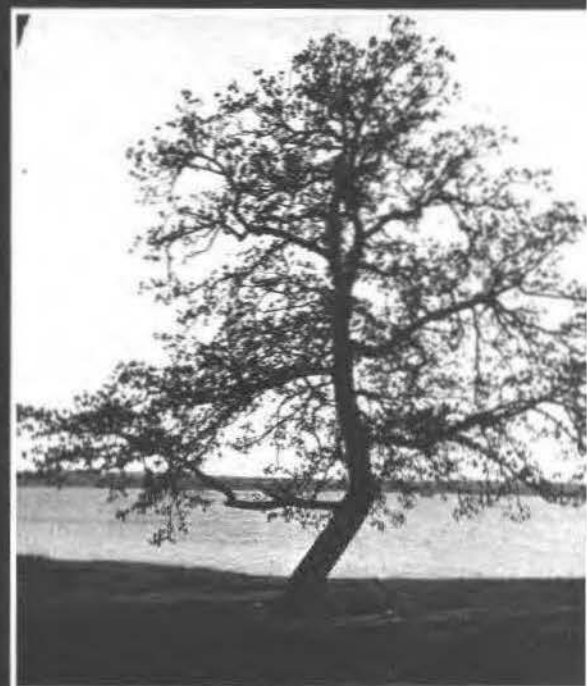
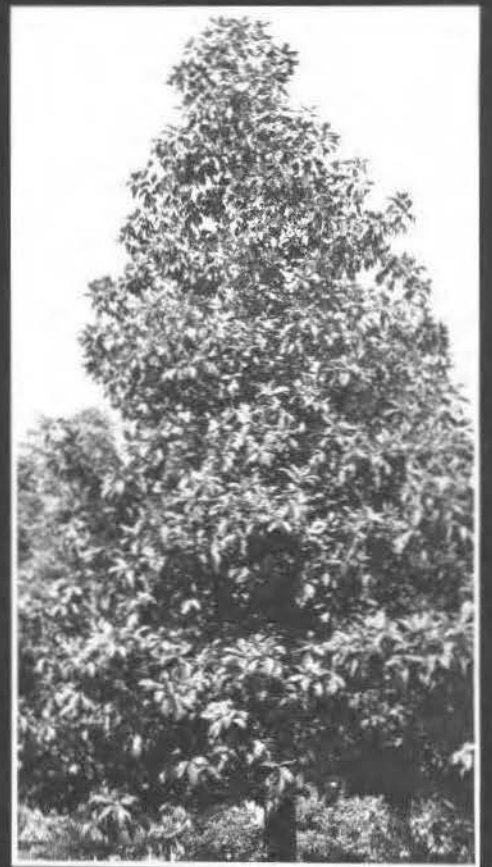

Timely projects such as the professional aviation program, which is one of the two in the United States, are examples of Dr. Shearer's concern for the present as well as the future.

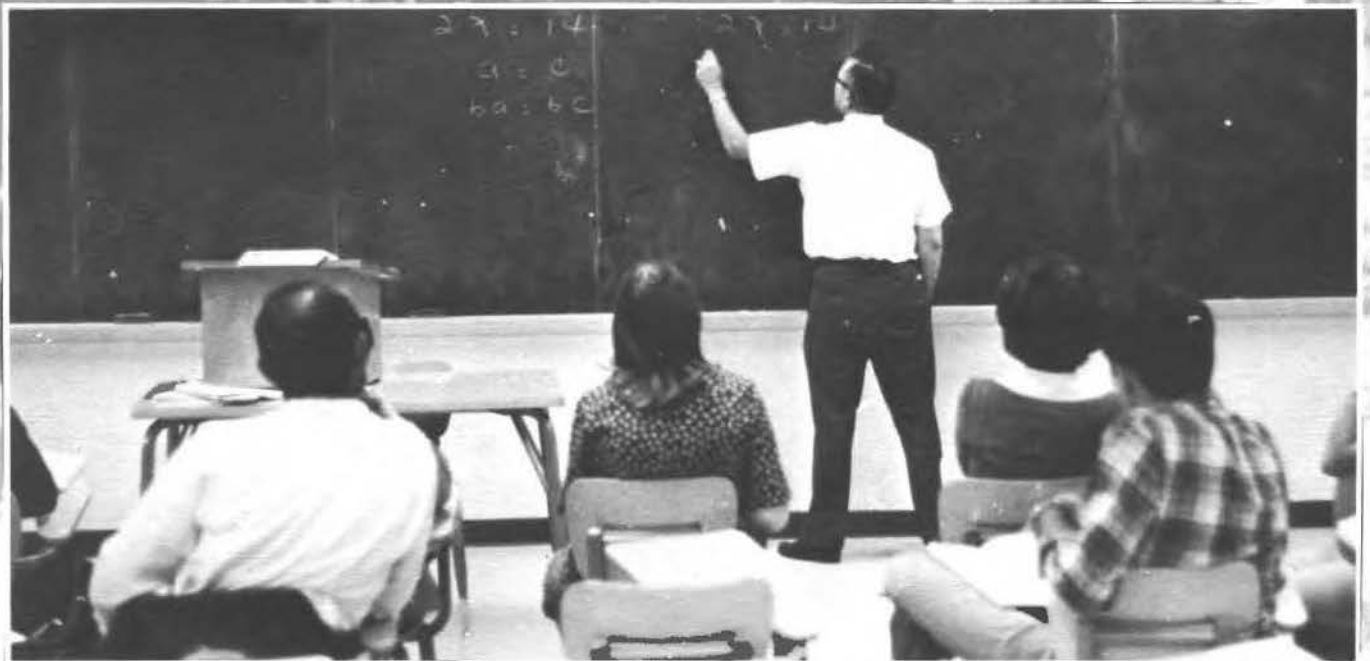
Mrs. Shearer, the first lady of the campus, shows concern and enthusiasm toward her husband's work and is always there to give the extra word of encouragement.

Participation in Intramural sport activities, by young men and women help balance the weight of their academic schedule.

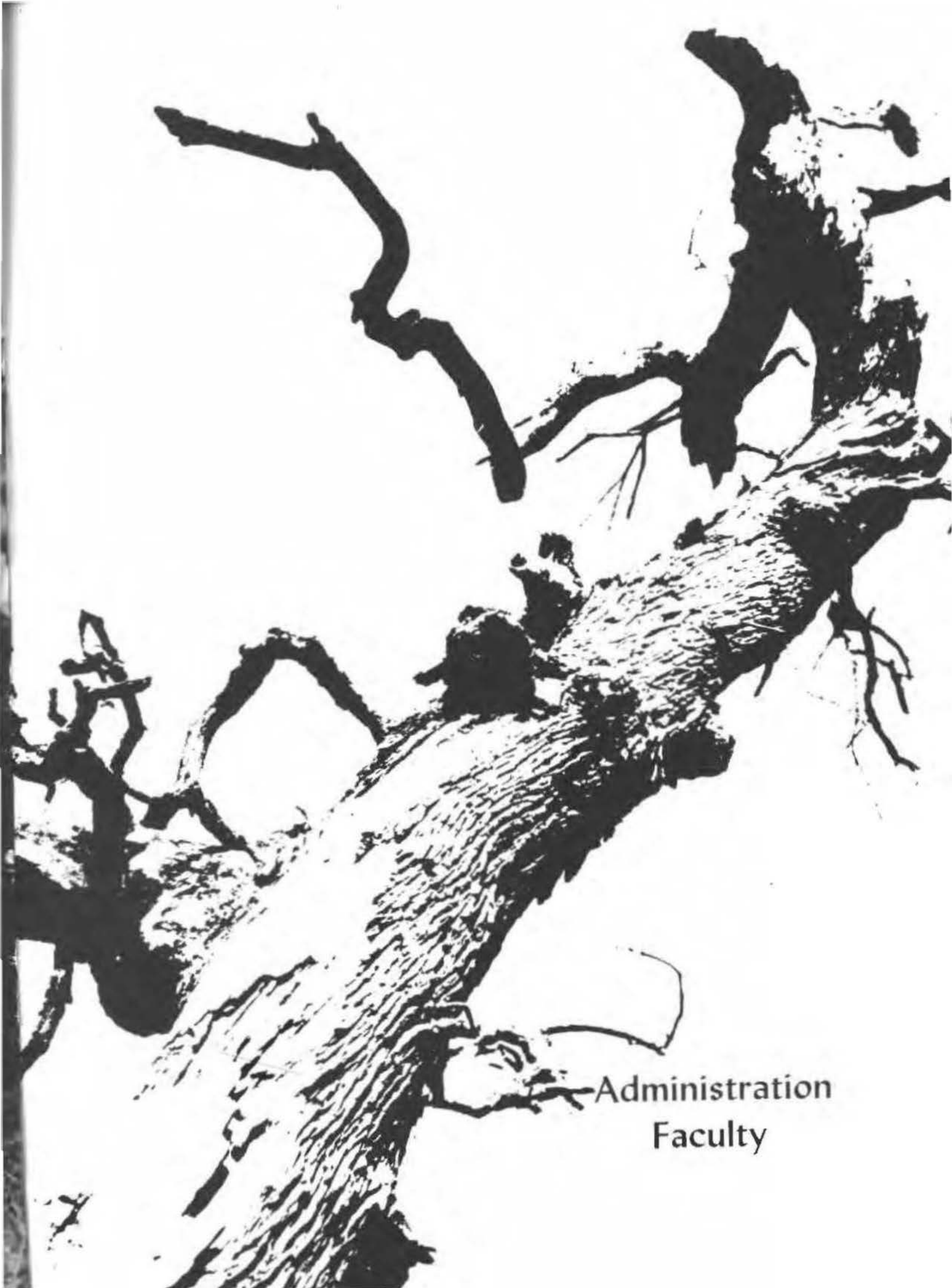
The library seems to be the most active building on campus and each student makes use of its facilities.

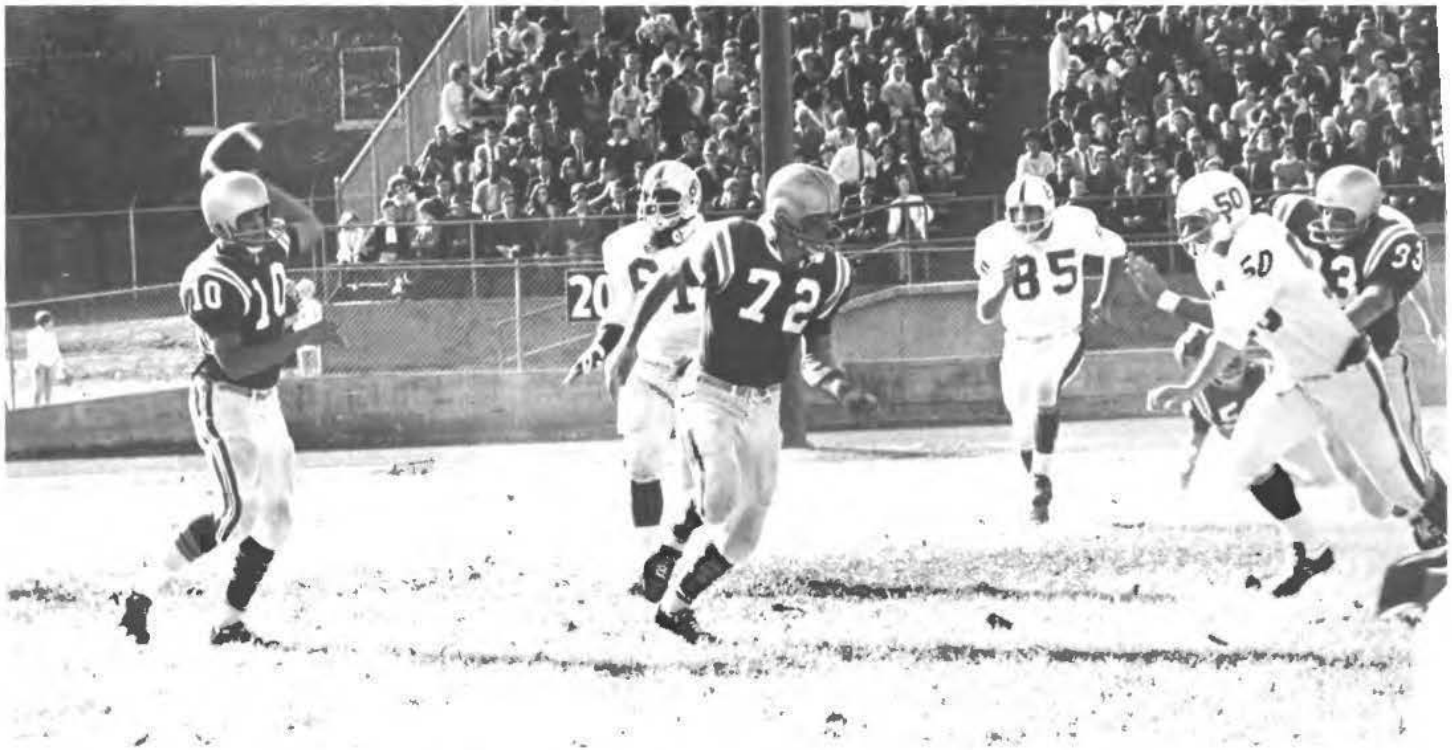

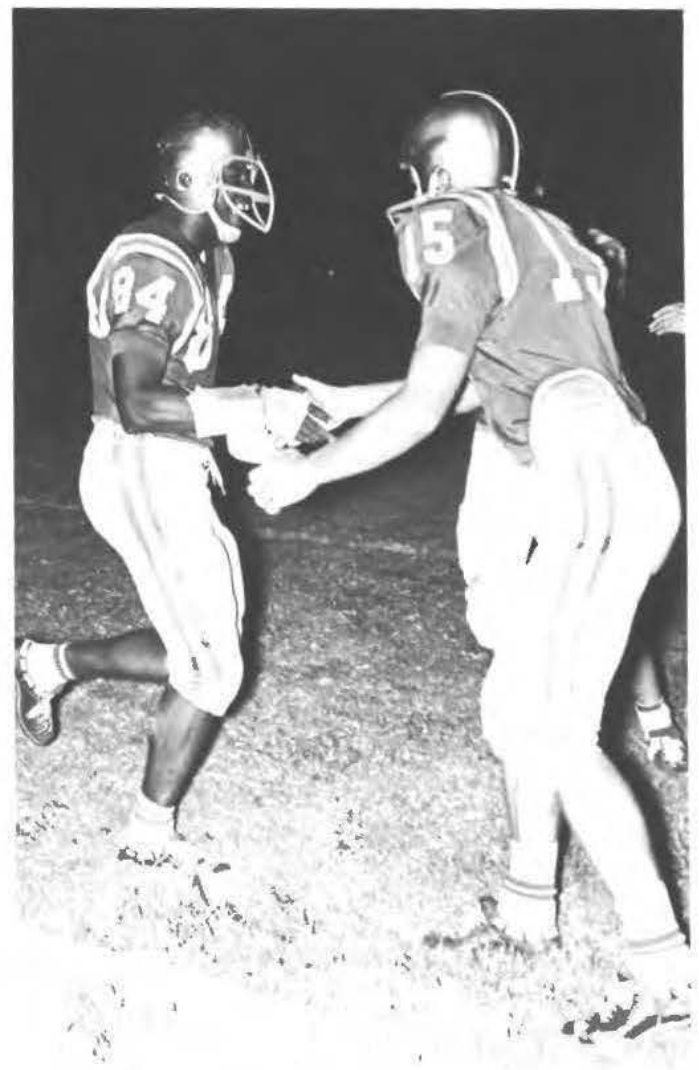

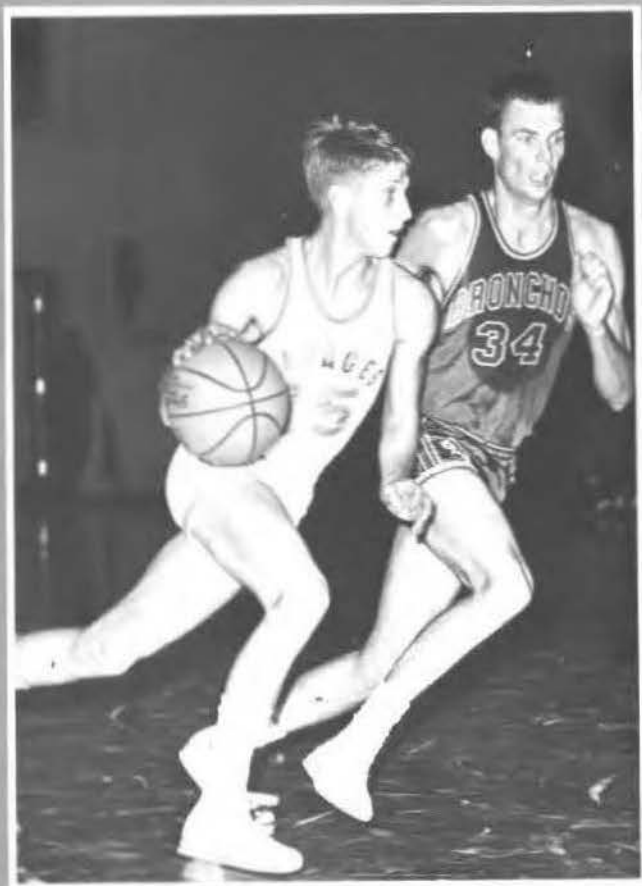

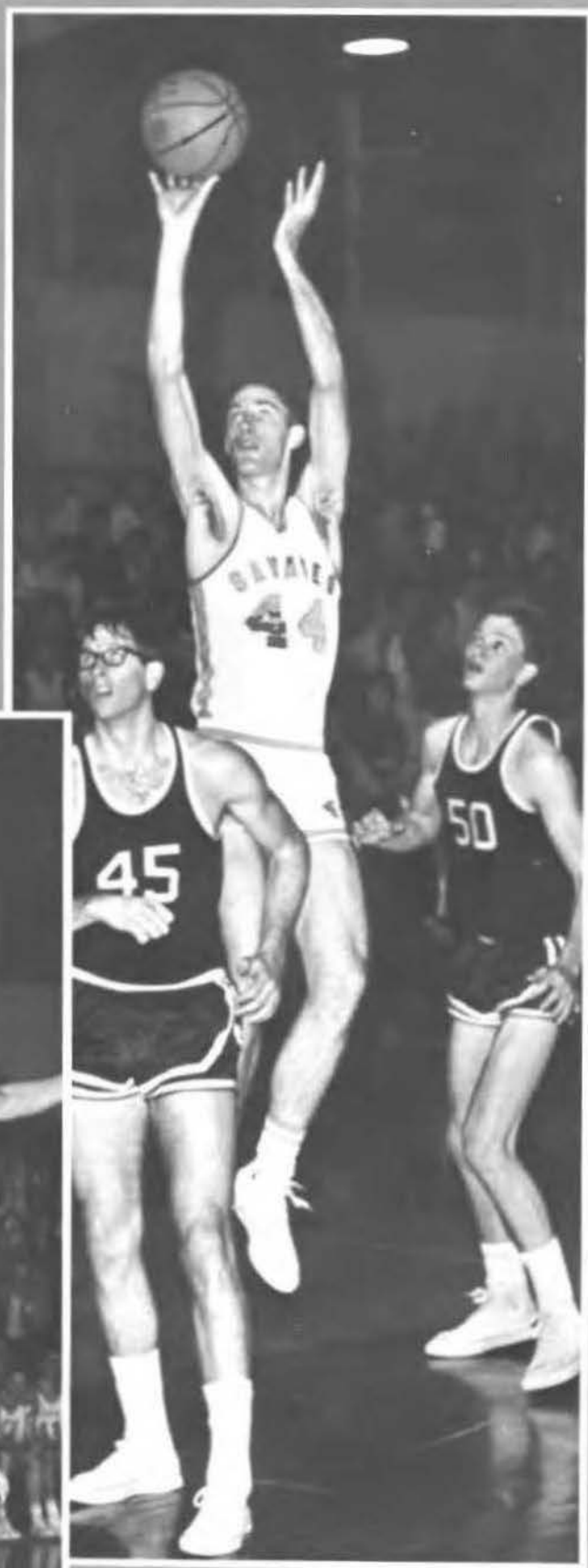

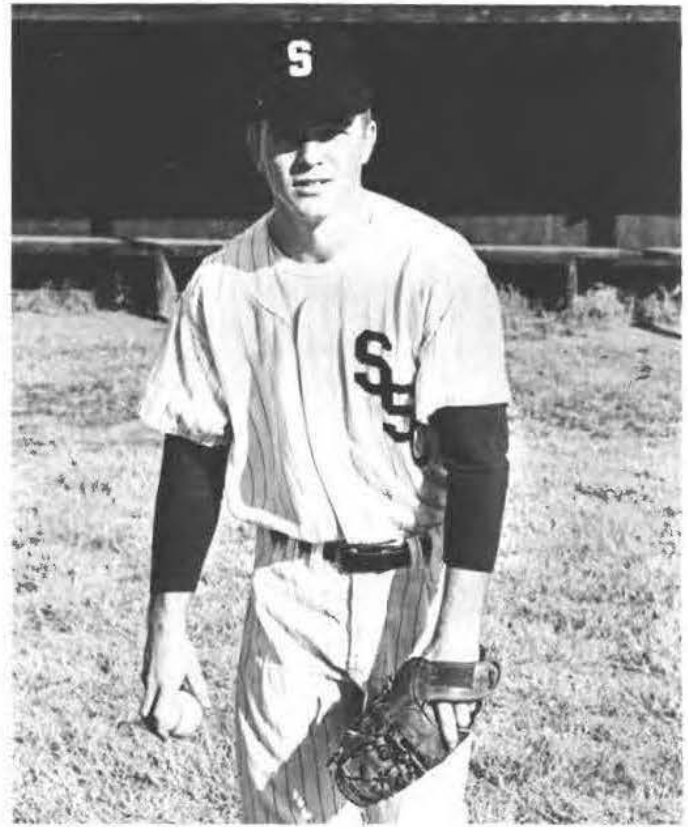

The annual Greek Charity Bowl football game again was championed by the Sigma Tau Gamma team.

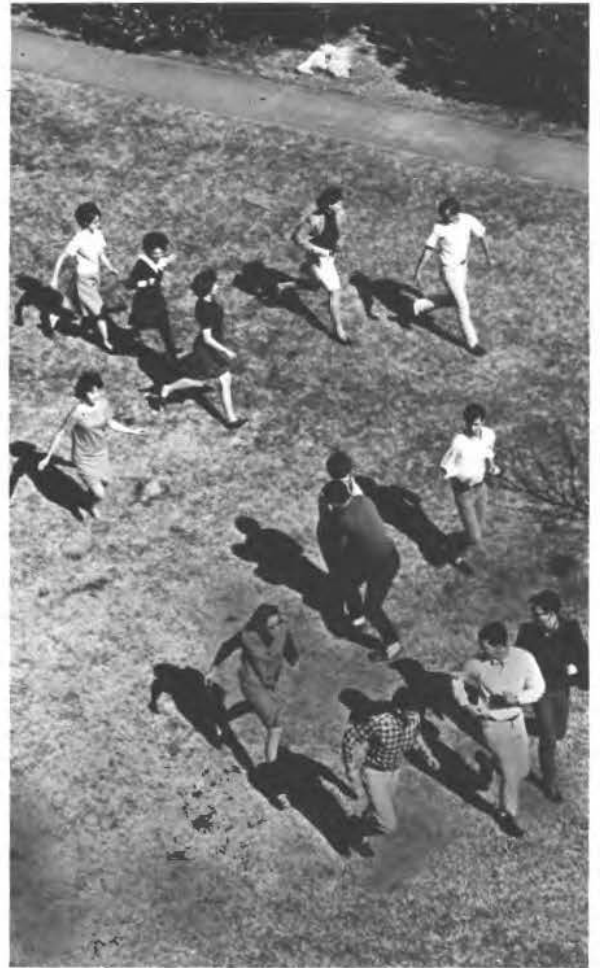
A highlight of the week was the first All-Greek (costumes with a Greek theme) Dance.
